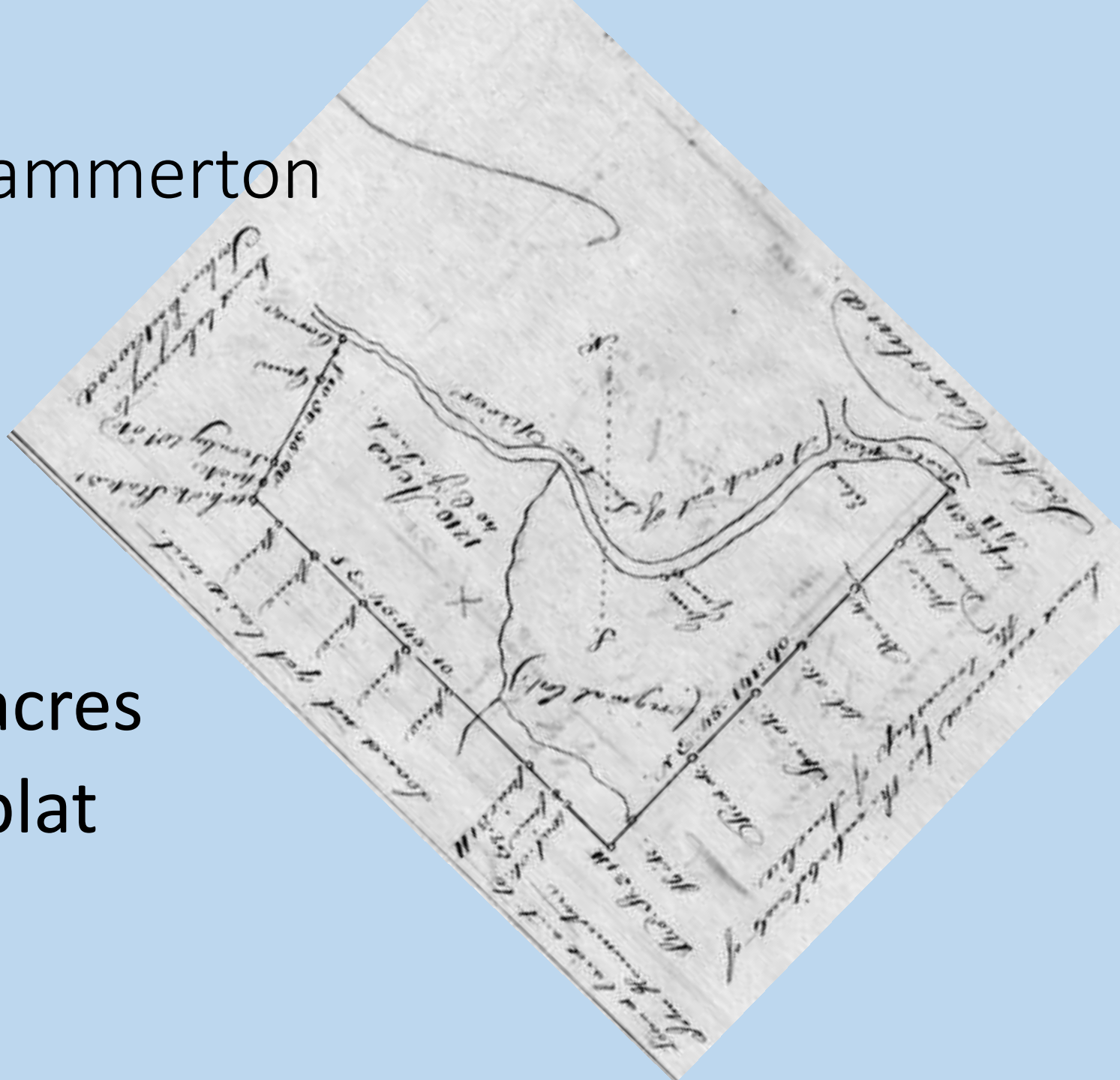


De Brahm's 1757 map – Amelia



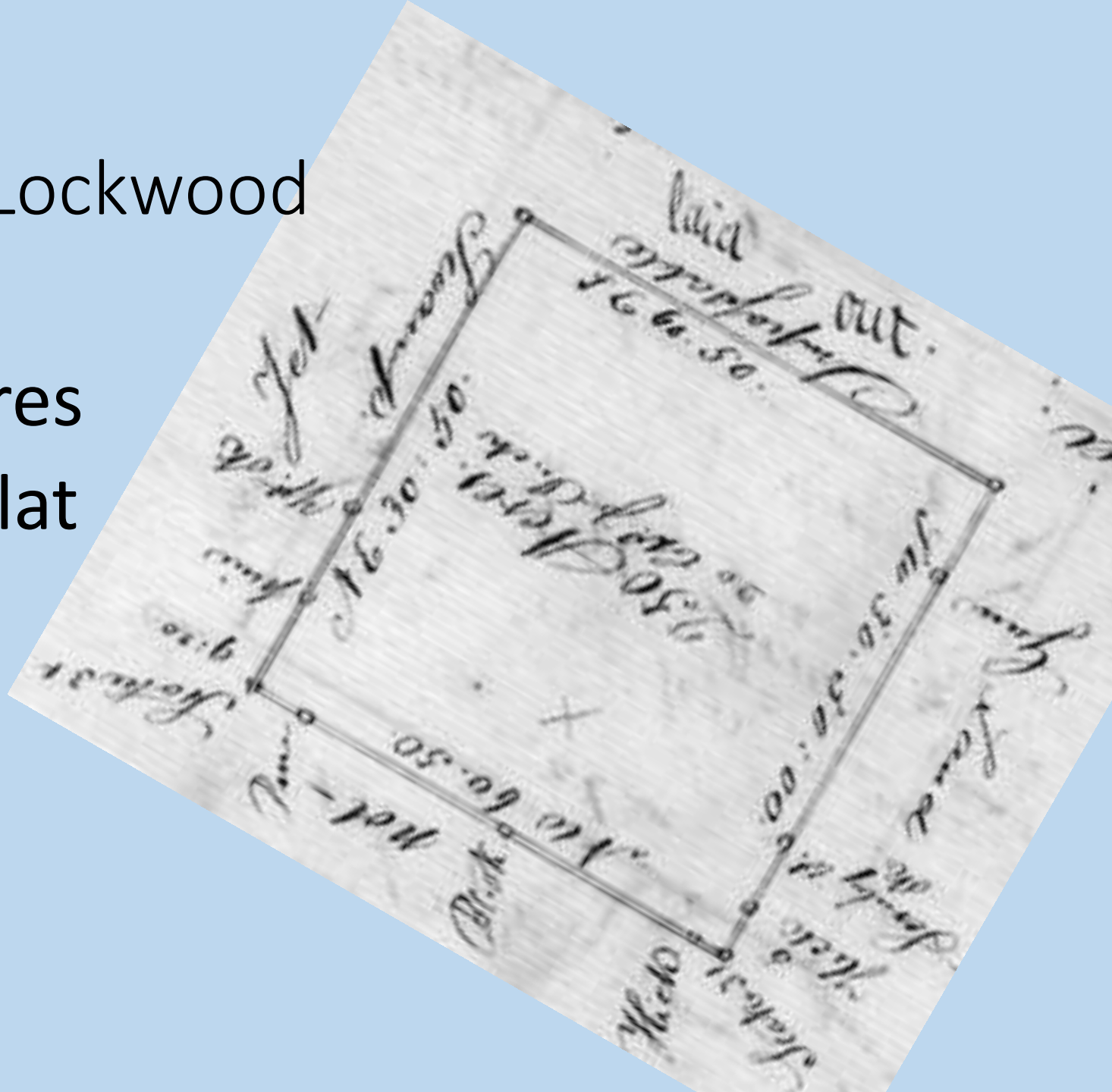

Mills' Atlas 1825 – Orangeburgh District – High Hill Creek

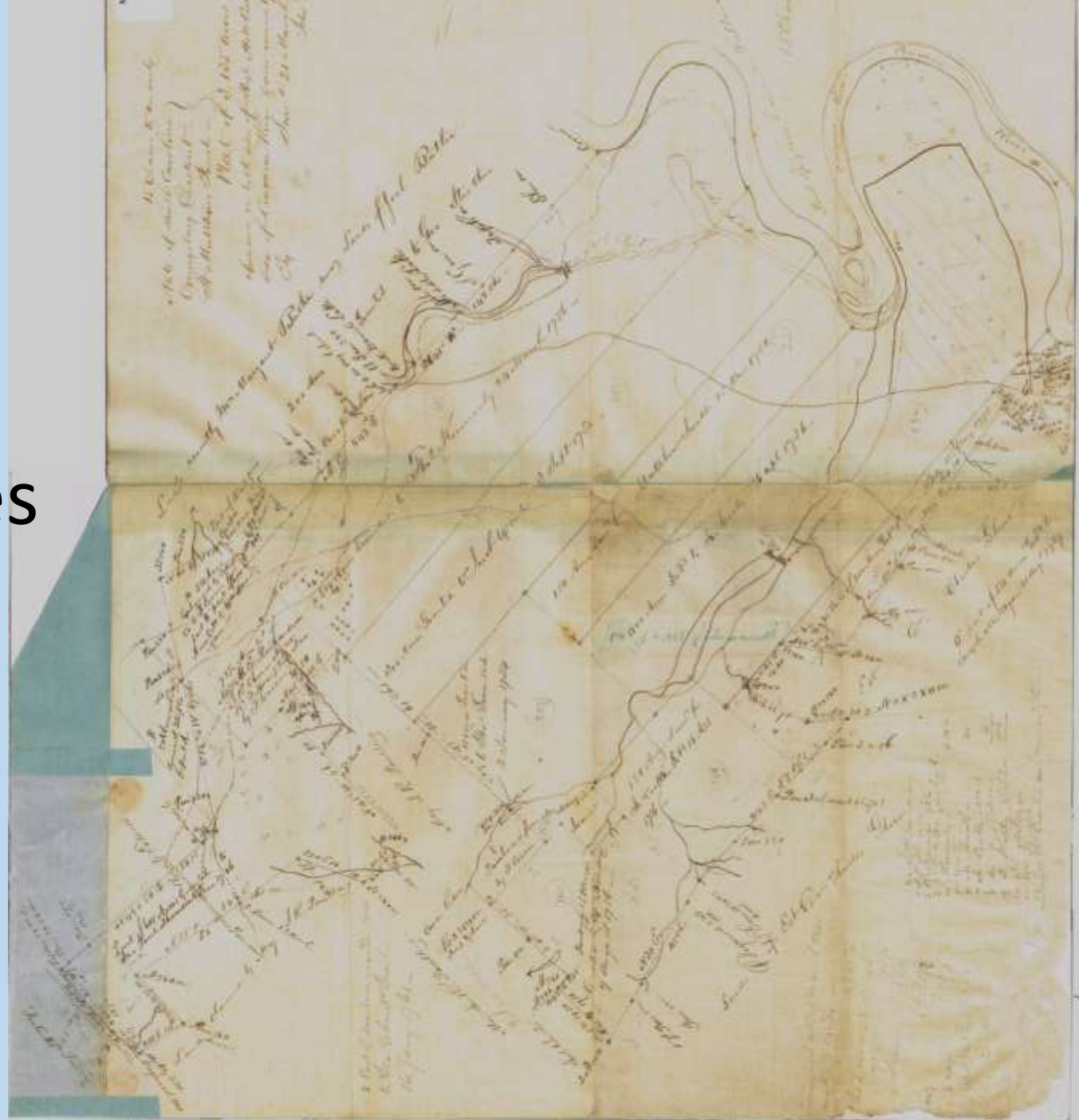


Mills' Atlas 1825 – road from Belleville to Beaver Creek

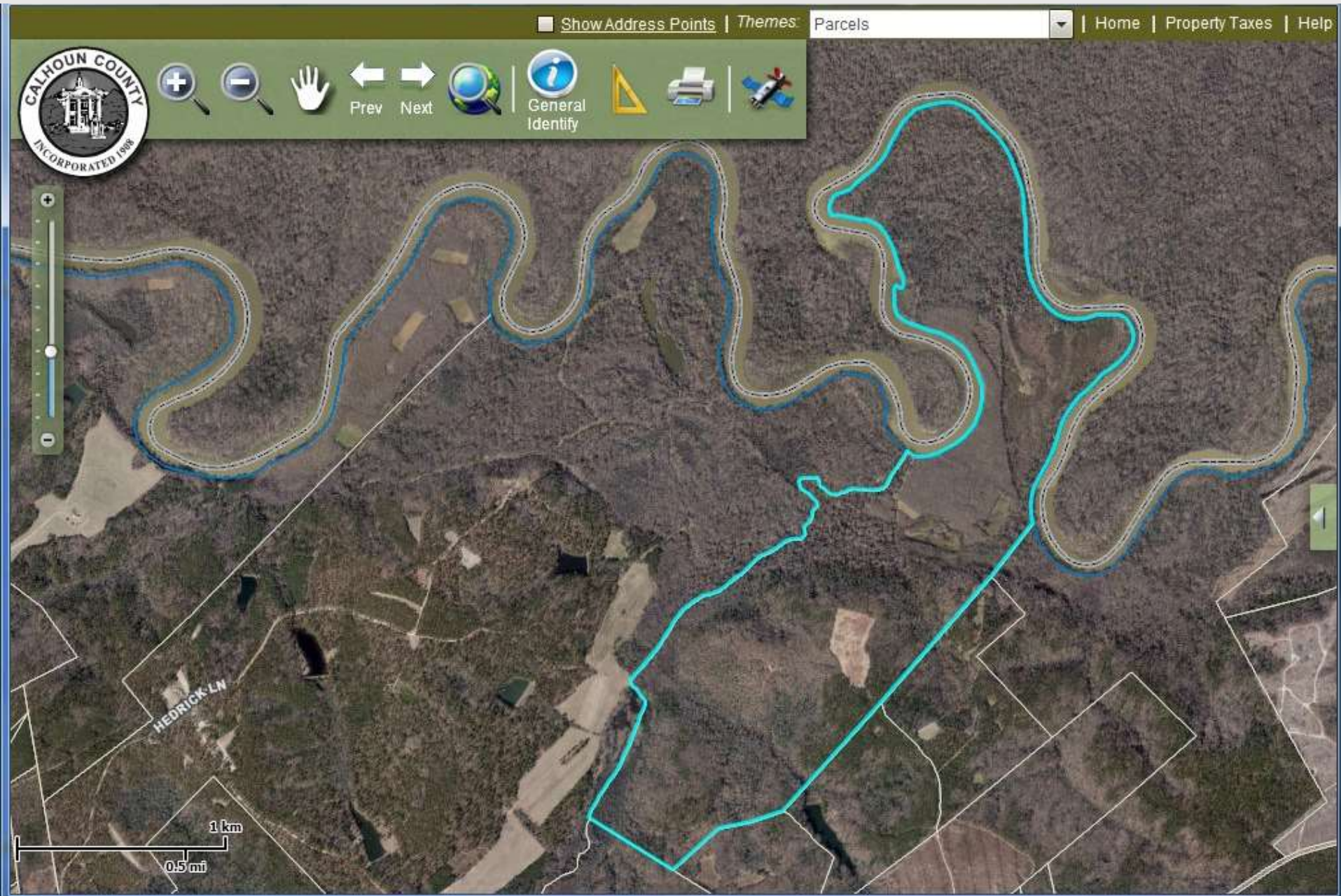

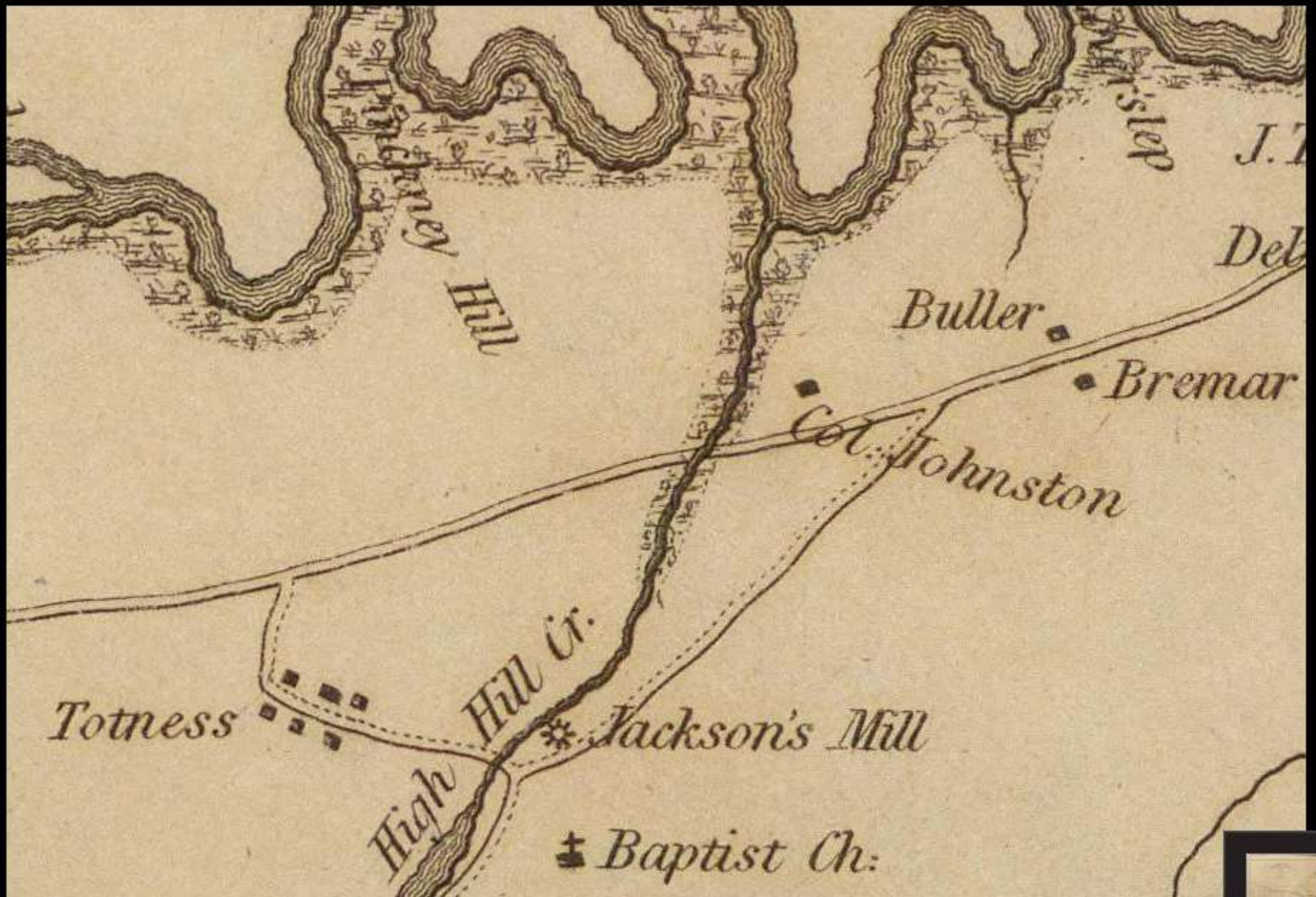

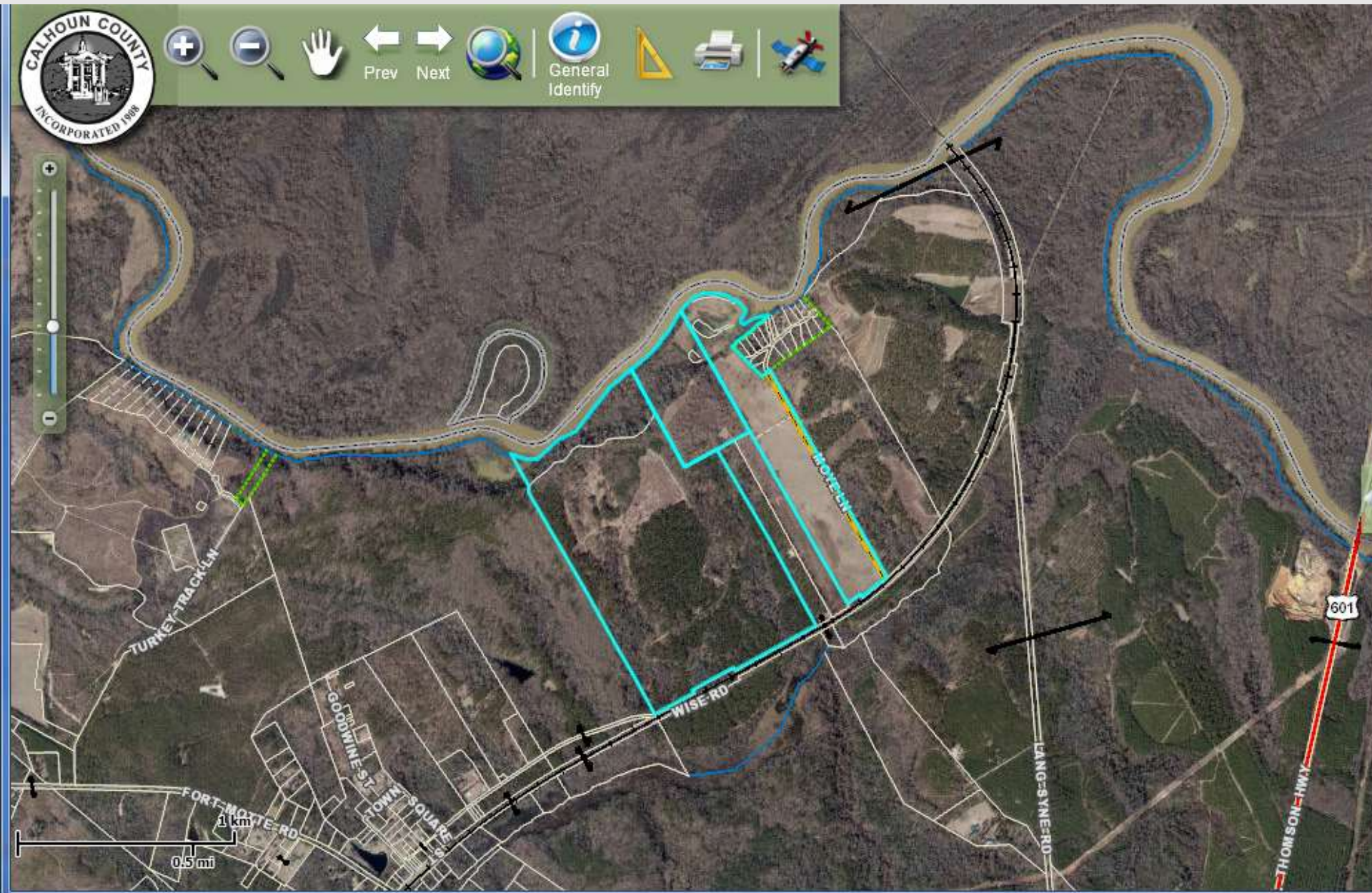
Thomas J. Goodwyn's plantation in 1870



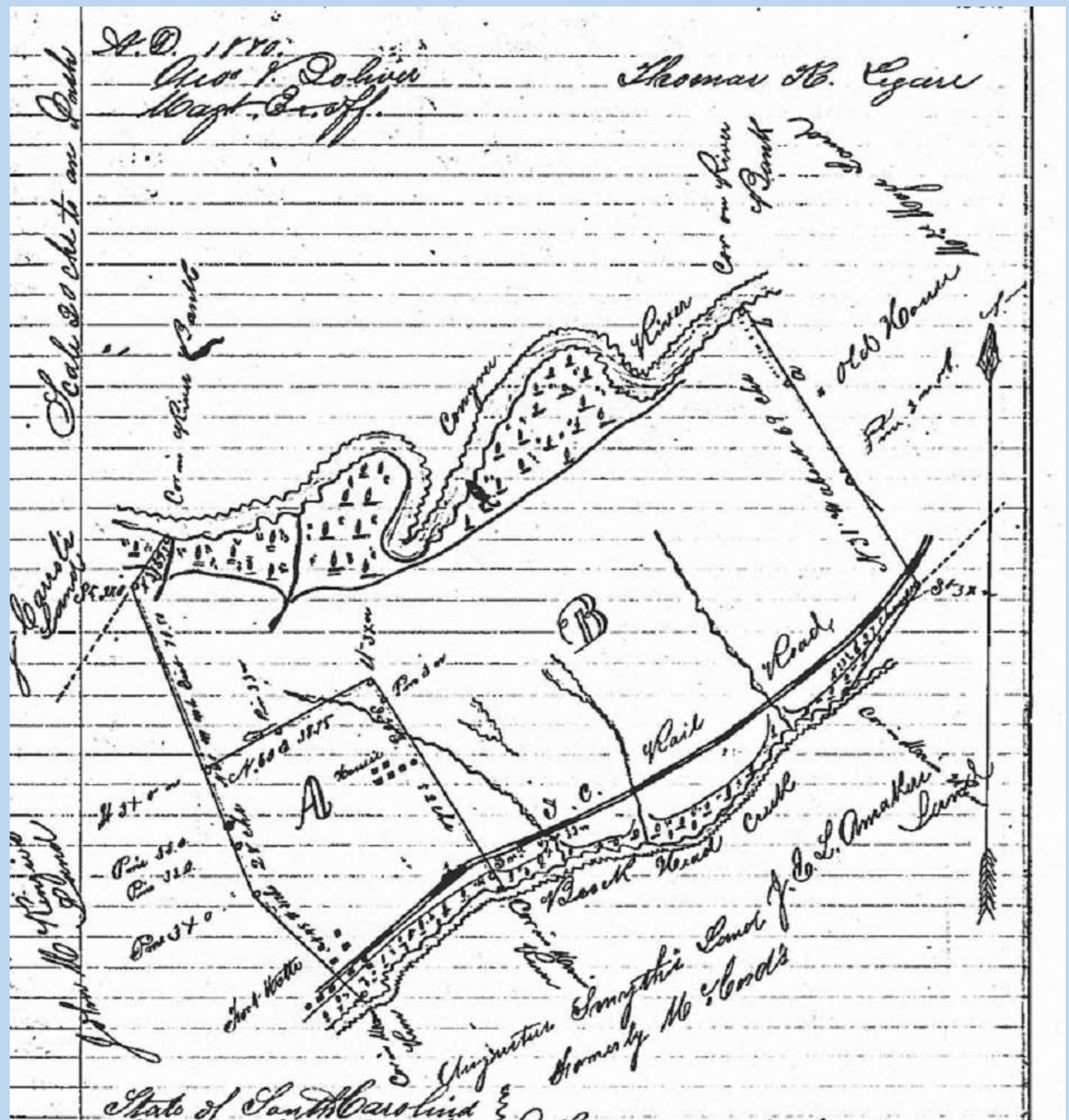

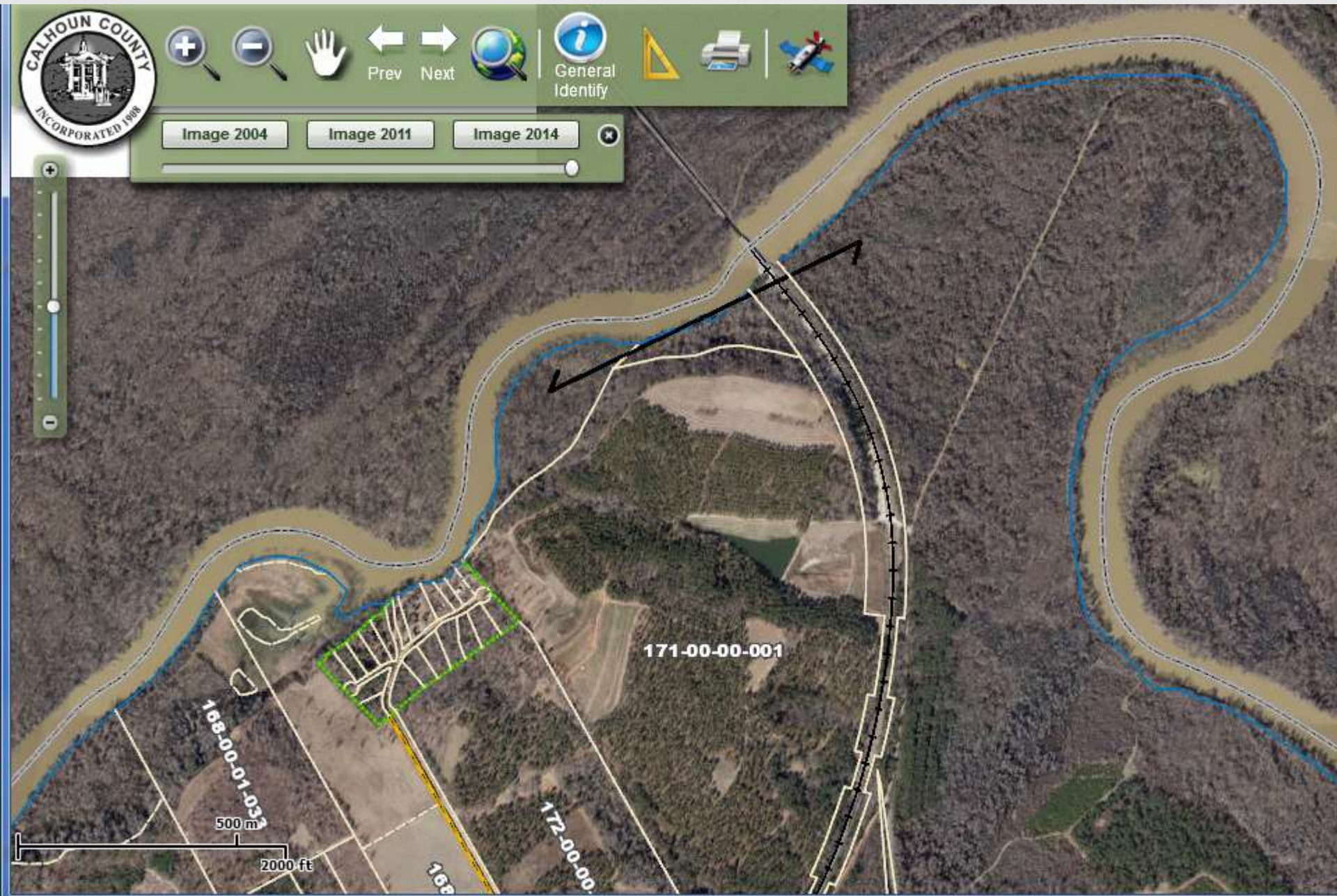
Cook's 1773 map – showing McCord's Ferry



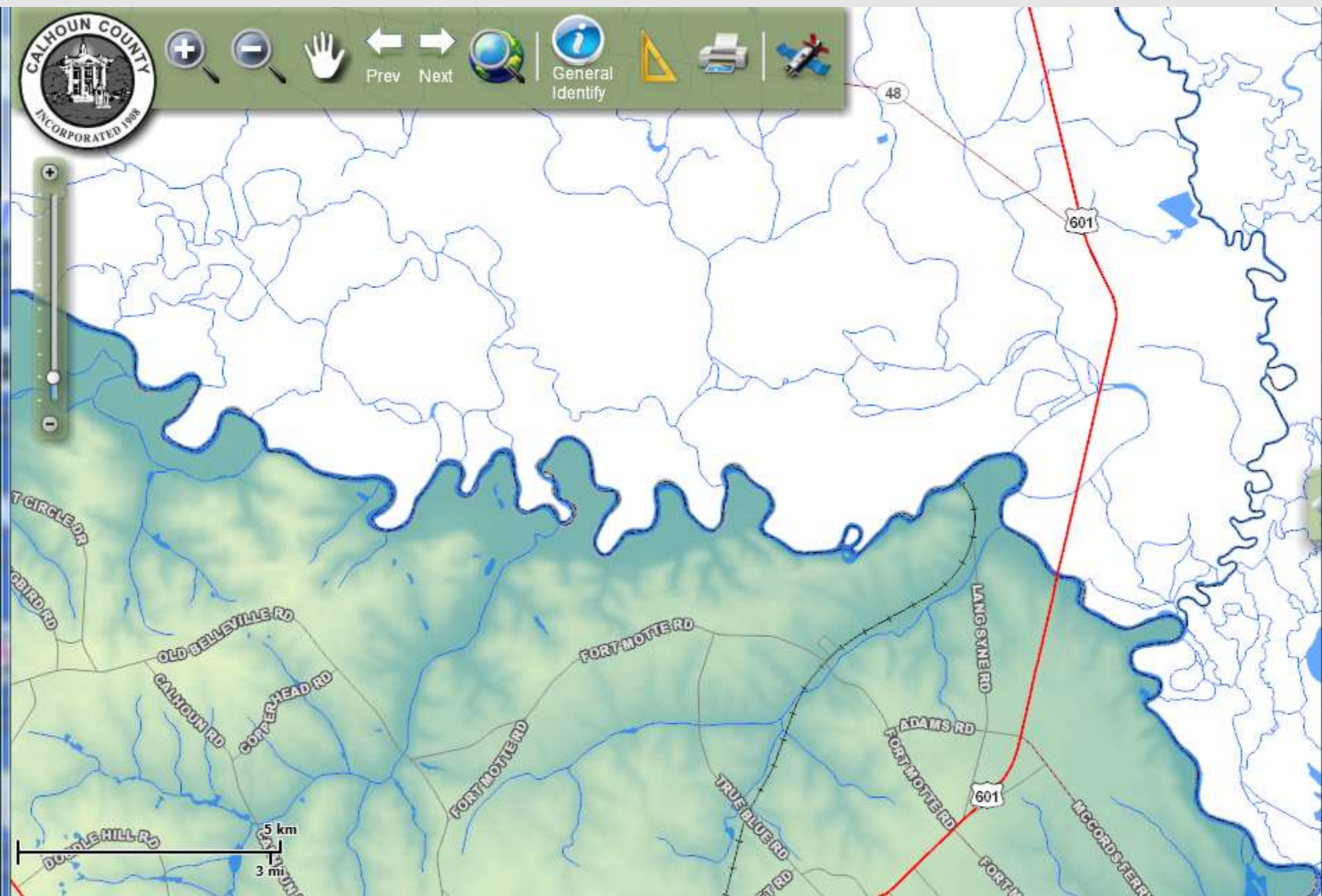

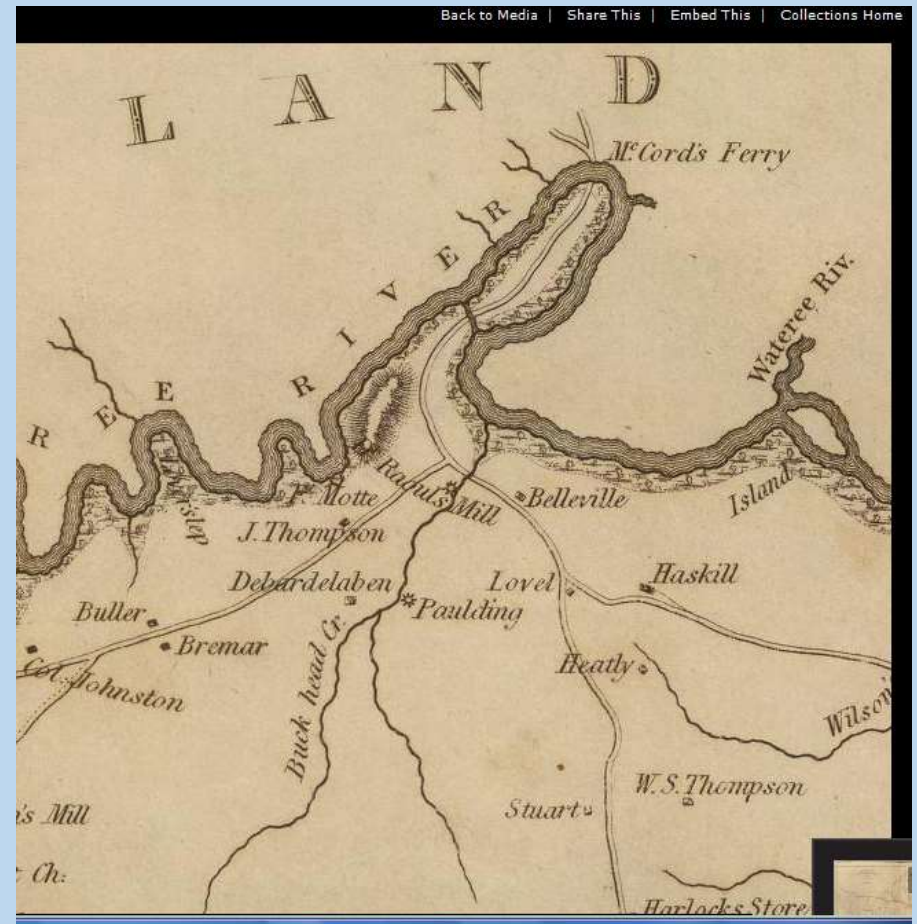


McCord's ferry on Congaree River

Cook's map 1773

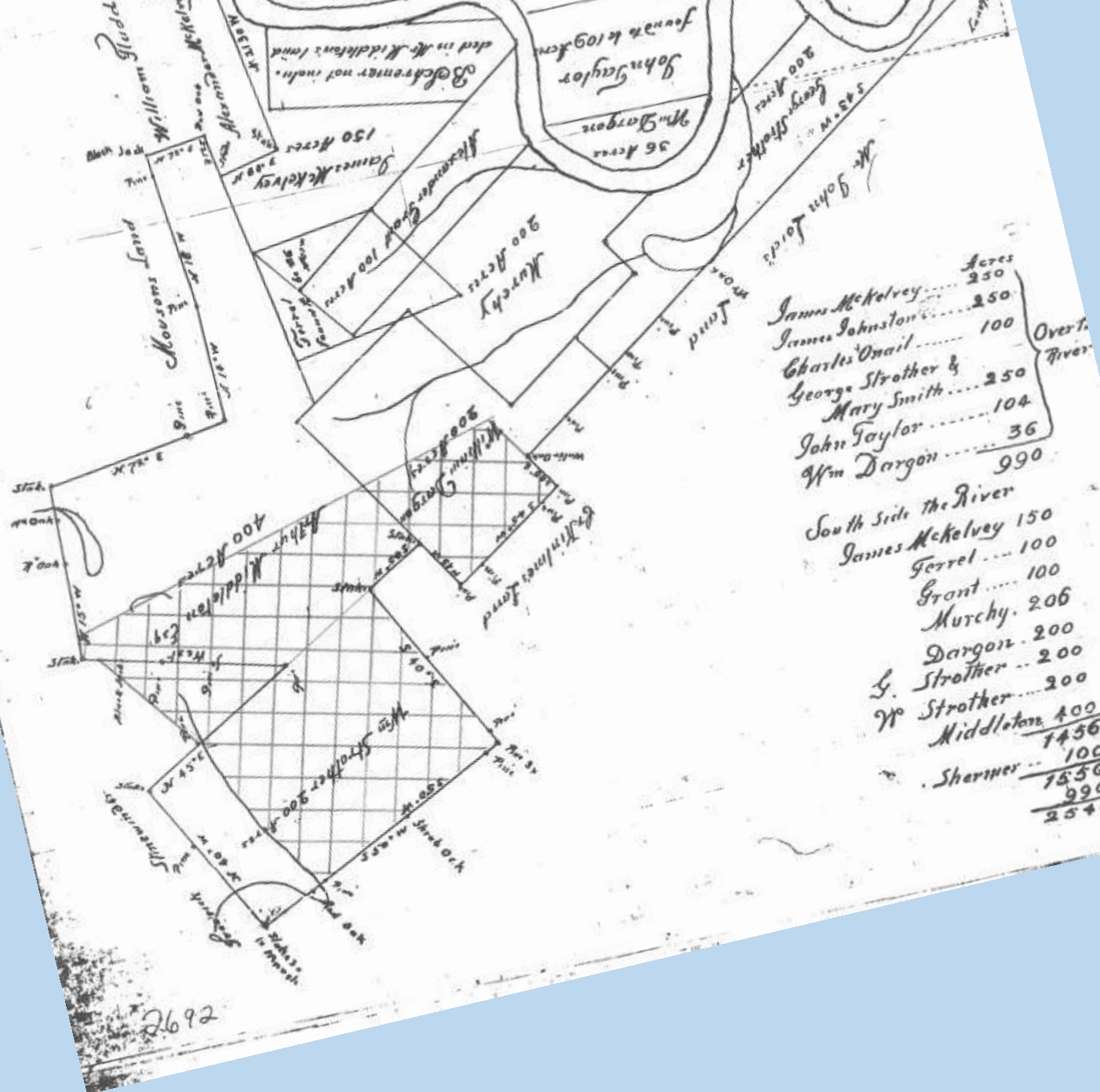
